What is a Green Card?

- The EB-3 visa or Green Card is your golden ticket to the United States.
- Officially known as a Permanent Residence Card, this document will allow you to legally immigrate, enjoy all the benefits of living in the U.S. and live your American Dream.
- Green Cards are valid for an initial period of ten years and can be renewed for subsequent ten-year terms.
- After residing for five years in the United States, you may become eligible to apply for American citizenship.

- **IETLS, Visa Screen & NCLEX** – Guidance and study preparation

After Arriving to the U.S.

Minimum of 12 months of current and consistent hospital experience in specialty of placement.

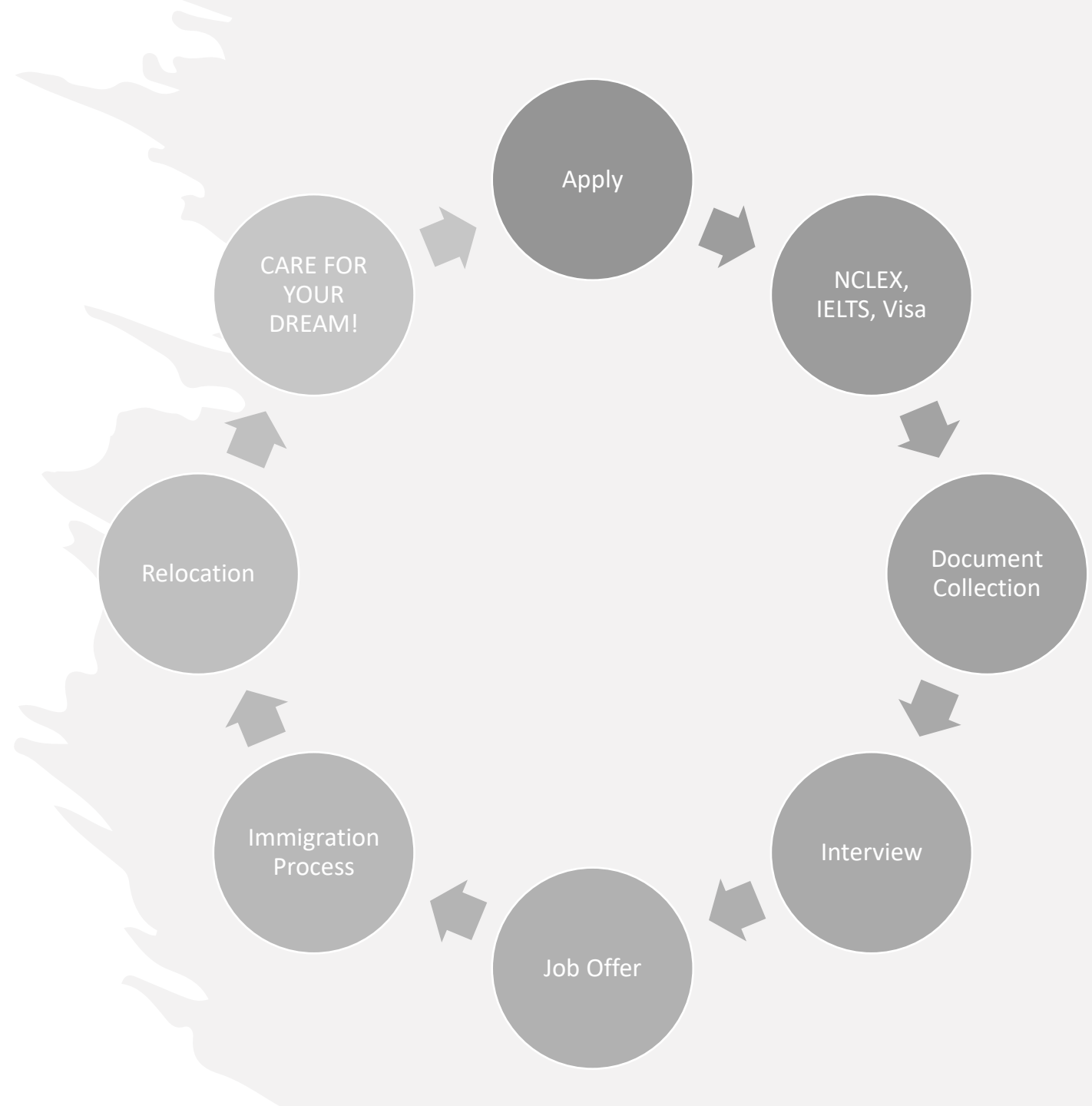
Language
